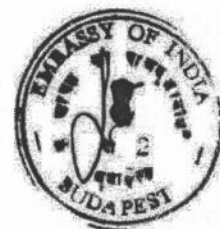
The Parliamentary Internship Programme provides opportunities for intensive study and practical training/orientation in parliamentary processes and procedures, with particular reference to the practices in the Parliament and State Legislatures in India.

The next programme "*International Training Programme in Legislative Drafting*" is scheduled to be held in New Delhi from 15 January to 15 February 2020. This Programme is designed to meet the need of equipping officials with the basic concepts, skills and techniques required for drafting legislation so that they can render assistance to the legislators, as and when required. The course is open to Senior Parliamentary/Government Officials who possess a Degree in Law.

The Embassy requests for suitable nominations for the course which is fully paid by the Government of India (airfare, living allowance, visa etc.). Nominations may be intimated before 13 December 2019 for the International Training Programme in Legislative Drafting.
