- 4) Photocopy of certificate of English Test
- 5) A copy of Passport or ID with photo (for checking nationality, name, sex, and date of birth).
- 6) 2 ID photos (4cm × 3cm) pasted on application form (Original and copy)
- 7) Health certificate (after receiving an acceptance notice from JICA)

Current duties: Young or middle-career government officials, prospective academics, or personnel from private institutions who are expected to contribute policy formulation or its implementation for tackling sustainable developmental issues in respective fields.
