Formalni kriteriji za prijem su sljedeći:

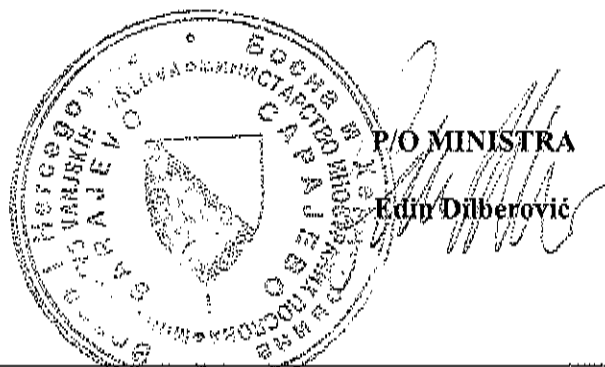
- Magisterij (prijava kandidata bez magisterija može se prihvatiti samo u iznimnim okolnostima);

Note: Full scholarships available for applicants from non-OECD countries

The application period is now open for the Master of Advanced Studies ETH Mediation in Peace Processes program. The application deadline is June 30, 2025.

The deadline for scholarship applications (only for individuals from non-OECD countries) is April 13, 2025. The scholarship covers the course fee, transportation, room and board.

We are looking for applications from individuals who want to professionalize their mediation practice. Ideal candidates have some relevant work experience and significant potential to be involved in and around mediation processes in the future. The formal admission criteria are as follows:

- Master's degree (applications from candidates without a Master's degree can be accepted only in exceptional circumstances);
- Career prospects for professional mediation-related activities in connection with peace processes;
- Relevant experience in mediation, peace processes, peacebuilding, or political negotiations in violent conflicts;
- English proficiency (Level: C1); language of instruction is English.
- Only for scholarships: you must be a citizen of a non-OECD country.

Developed in collaboration with the United Nations (UN) and the Foreign Ministries of Switzerland, Finland, Germany, and supported by regional organizations such as the EU and the OSCE, the MAS ETH MPP is a globally unique two-year program focused specifically on mediation in peace processes. The program entails 15 weeks of face-to-face teaching in Zurich spread over two years, allowing for continued work at home between modules while investing in course-related readings and written papers.
